# Story Time Comes Alive



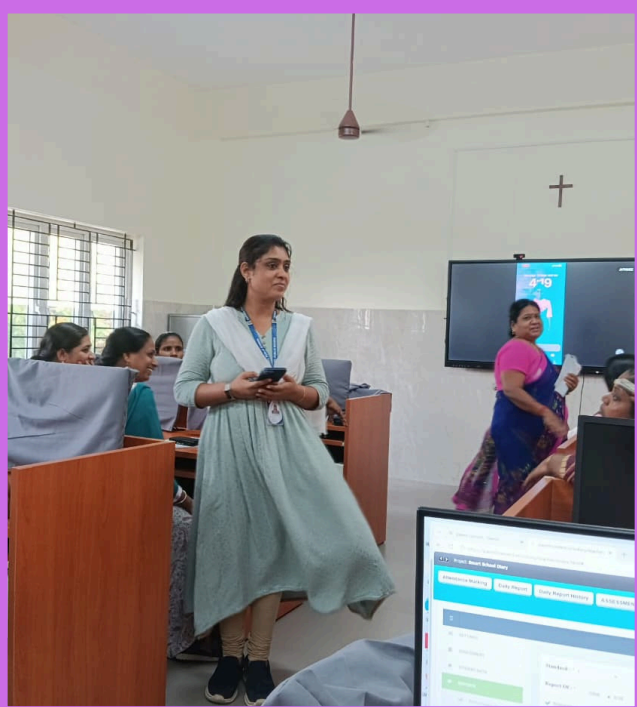
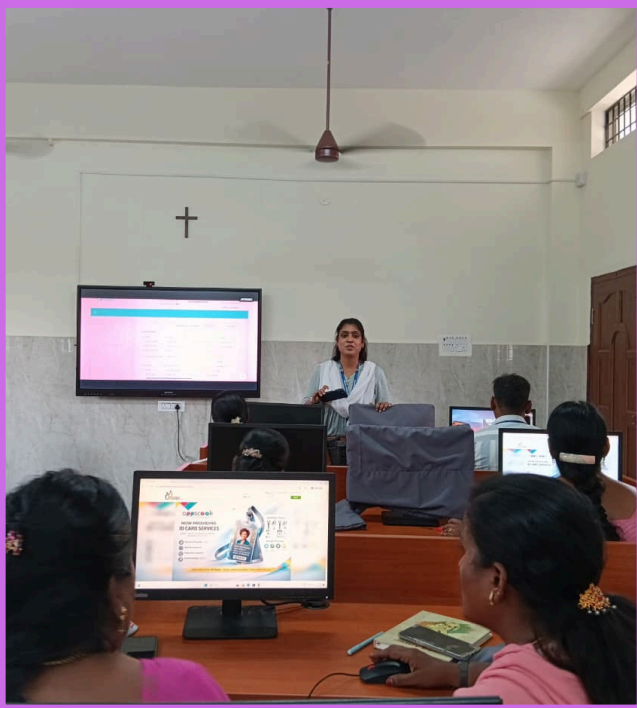

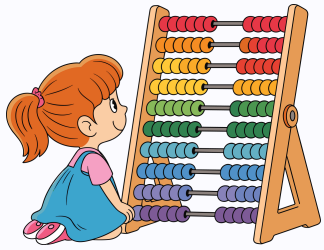


# Scouts and Guides – Rajya Puraskar Pretest Camp

The course completion marked a significant achievement for the students, encouraging their overall growth and skill development.

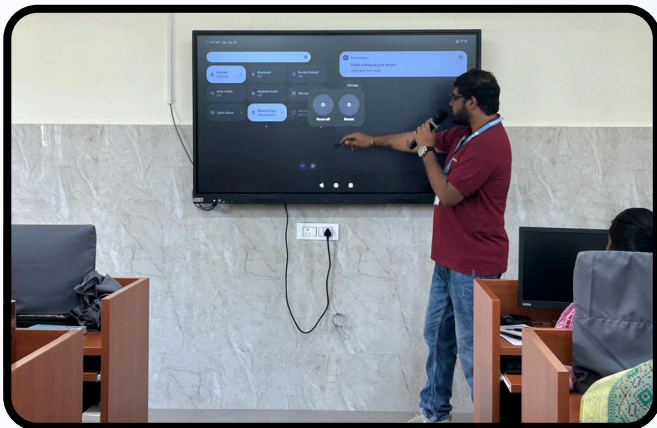


# Smart Teaching Solutions – Training Workshop
